

Dear Church Family,

Beginning August 1st, our Sunday morning schedule will be changing. We will have simultaneous Sunday School and Worship Service hours beginning at 9am and 10:30am. The most obvious changes are the addition of the second Sunday School session and the change in the starting times. The addition of the second Sunday School session is necessitated by the fact that we are completely out of educational space in our current Sunday School and we are at capacity in our 11:00 Worship Service. We are really excited about how God's Spirit is moving at Kennesaw First Baptist Church. Even though change brings challenge, we are so thankful for the hand of God!

Below is a list of "frequently asked questions" that we hope you will find helpful in determining your Sunday morning schedule preference.

When does the new schedule begin?

We will begin our new schedule on Sunday, August 1st, 2010.

What times will the services start?

The first Sunday School session and worship service will begin at 9am. The second Sunday School and worship service will begin at 10:30am.

What style of music will we have in each hour?

More than anything, we want our corporate worship times to be scriptural and, regarding the music, we desire to provide our church family, from kindergarten to senior adult, an opportunity to express love and praise to God, and to focus on God's divinity. To that end, our worship services will be identical in format and content. We will have a choir sing in both services and we will utilize the piano, organ, worship team and band in each service. We desire that worship style become less a focus and Christ be "the" focus. Therefore, each week we will seek to follow the Spirit's leading versus intentional thinking along the lines of worship style.

How long do we anticipate keeping this schedule?

As God continues to bless us with numerical growth we should be prepared for future change. When we reach the point where we need space in our current Worship Center, we will add a third morning service. At that point we will have worship service at 8:15am, 9:30am and 11:00am. Sunday School sessions will be held at 9:30am and 11:00am.

How does the new Sunday morning schedule impact my Sunday School class?

New classes are being organized and current teachers are selecting which Sunday School hour they will attend. We will need volunteers to attend the new classes so please be in prayer about how God may be leading you in this decision.

How does the new schedule impact the Student Ministry?

The plan is for our students to enjoy the same graded Sunday School classes as they do presently. Leaders are needed for the new classes in the Student Ministry. Please contact Jody Livingston if you feel God is leading you to assist in this area.

We hope that this answers many of your questions. We are looking forward to the months ahead. As the summer progresses, the staff will continue to work out the details of our new schedule. Let us know if you have questions or want further information and we'll do our best to accommodate.
